


Obtaining a Wisconsin State ID Card for FREE



Wisconsin does not issue a separate "Voter ID" card. Driver Licenses, State IDs, and some other photo IDs can be used as ID for voting purposes.

You must have one document from each column to obtain a FREE State ID For Voting Purposes. Here's what must be brought to the DMV.

- Name & Date of Birth**
- BIRTH CERTIFICATE (certified)
 - CERTIFICATE OF CITIZENSHIP
 - DRIVER LICENSE (Other U.S.)
 - FOREIGN PASSPORT (valid)
 - TSA WORKER ID Transportation Worker Identification Credential
 - ARRIVAL / DEPARTURE RECORD
 - COURT ORDER: Adoption, Divorce Name or Gender

 - CERTIFICATE OF CITIZENSHIP

You do not have to show your Social Security Card, but must provide the number.

Documents presented as proof must be original. Photocopies unless otherwise indicated are not acceptable.

Documents with a photograph of a person will be accepted only when the person is readily recognizable from the photograph.

One Document Can Satisfy Multiple Columns

One acceptable document can be used as proof in multiple categories. Proof in each category does not mean four different acceptable documents.

Original Documents of Proof

The DMV will decline to accept any acceptable document presented if it has reason to suspect the authenticity of the document. Questionable documents may require additional review.

The same documents are required when applying for a Driver License.



SECTION A - APPLICANT - PLEASE PRINT CHECK ONE, I am applying for: Driver License Identification Card

For ID Applicants Only – I certify that I am a United States citizen, will be at least 18 years of age by the next election and require a Wisconsin Identification Card (ID) for free in order to vote.

Once documentation is accepted the FREE State ID Card is processed and mailed. A WI State ID Card Receipt is issued. The WI State ID Card Receipt is an acceptable ID for voting purposes.

New Wisconsin Residents

Complete the application:

Wisconsin Driver License (DL)/Identification Card (ID).

When applying for an original (first) Wisconsin State ID Card documents must be presented that prove: your name, date of birth, legal presence, identity and Wisconsin residency. A list of acceptable documents of proof are on the backside of this page.


Valid out-of-state drivers licenses must be surrendered when obtaining a Wisconsin State ID Card.

Voter ID Law

WHEN USING A WI STATE ID CARD TO VOTE A SEPARATE WI STATE ID IS NOT REQUIRED.

The Wisconsin State ID Card is a statutory photo ID that can be used as proof of identification to vote. The Wisconsin State ID Card should be unexpired, or if expired have expired after the date of the most recent general election: currently, **November 2, 2010.**

Regular Wisconsin State ID Card costs \$28 (renewable in 8 yrs)

One Can Be More Documents of Proof


One acceptable document can be used as proof in multiple categories. Proof in each category does not mean four different acceptable documents.

Original Documents of Proof

The acceptable documents used must be original. Photocopies are not acceptable. The DMV will decline to accept any acceptable document presented if it has reason to suspect the authenticity of the document.

Once documentation is accepted the State ID Card is processed and mailed. A WI State ID Card Receipt is issued. The WI State ID Card Receipt is an acceptable ID for voting purposes.

Request is processed within TWO days and the product is then shipped via USPS.
